Thank you for considering Utica College for graduate education. In order to avoid delay in processing your application, please read the following instructions carefully before filling out the attached application.

Required GPA-3.0 out of a possible 4.0

Entrance tests—Any <u>one</u> of the following may be used for application to the Education programs. Specific programs may require successful passage of the CST and LAST (See information below and on back for specific program requirements):

1. Miller Analogies Test (MAT) - The Graduate Admissions Office at Utica College administers the MAT. The test takes an hour, is done online and you receive the score immediately when you are through. Cost is \$75 and may be taken Monday through Friday at the Graduate Admissions Office, 120 White Hall.
